Brief overview

Iron Wall Division is tasked to stop the enemy from further advancing into the heart of the homeland. The division is expected to construct fortifications and defensive positions behind the frontlines and become its garrison.

Division Commander:

- **Major General Caldred Varden**
 - A seasoned officer of multiple war fronts known for his boldness, strict discipline, tactical brilliance, and unwavering brutality against the advancing enemy. Specialized in siege warfare and defensive operations.

Strength:

- **Total Personnel:** 15,000 soldiers
- **Total Weapons:** ~17,000 small arms

Primary Components:

Infantry Brigades

- 1st Ironwood Brigade (Veteran Infantry)
- 2nd Shield Brigade (Heavy Infantry such as machine gunners and armored soldiers)
- 3rd Riflearms Brigade (Basic Infantry)

Artillery Brigade

- “Hammers of Mostia” Field Artillery Battalion
 - 24x 75mm field guns
 - 12x 120mm howitzers
 - 6x experimental 81mm mortars

Cavalry Detachment

- “Pursuing Sabres” Light Cavalry Corps

- Primarily horse-mounted, equipped with carbines and sabers, with a few armored steam-cars for reconnaissance.

Engineering Corps

- “Red Sapper”
 - Builds bridges, fortification construction; bunkers, pillboxes, trench works, walls, and forts. Demolition squad.

Medical Corps

- “Defenders of Blood”
 - Combat medics trained to assist and provide cover to non combatant medical personnel.
- “Red Post” Medical Personnel Volunteers
 - 4 mobile field hospitals, fully staffed with surgeons, nurses, and stretcher-bearers.

Signal Corps

- “Silver Lines” Signal Company
 - Equipped with telegraphy stations, semaphore flags, and trained runners for battlefield communication.

Supply Corps

- “Stubborn Mules”
 - Hundreds of wagons, pack animals, and a few steam lorries to move ammunition, food, water, and spare parts.

Headquarters Staff

Chief of Staff, Intelligence Officer, Operations Officer, Logistics Officer, Medical Officer.

Planning and overseeing division-wide movements and engagements.

Standard equipment:

Primary

- Rifle:
 - G81 (Garlian 1881 11x60mm)
- Submachine gun:
 - MMP80 (Mostian Machine Pistol 9mm)
 - V85 (Vezi 1885 9mm)
- Machine gun:
 - Autmata (Multi-barrel, crank-operated machine gun 1862 11.62mm)

Side arm

- Revolvers:
 - K80.36 (Kalith 1880 .36)
 - P1878 (Palner 1878 7.5mm)

Specialized equipment:

- Bullet resistant chestplate armor issued to sentries.
- Flamethrowers.
- Steam-powered trench diggers for rapid fortification building.
- Armored steam-cars
- Geza Mk. 2 Bayonets

Operational Doctrine

Emphasizes defensive strength and counter-assault.

Uses artillery to wear down the enemy advance before they reach Iron Wall Division's defensive lines.

Cavalry provides scouting, reconnaissance, as well as cutting down retreating soldiers and deserters.

Engineers construct vast and tight defensive structures and positions.

Maintains high logistical discipline to avoid supply failures.

Do not pursue fleeing enemies and let the cavalry do the chasing.

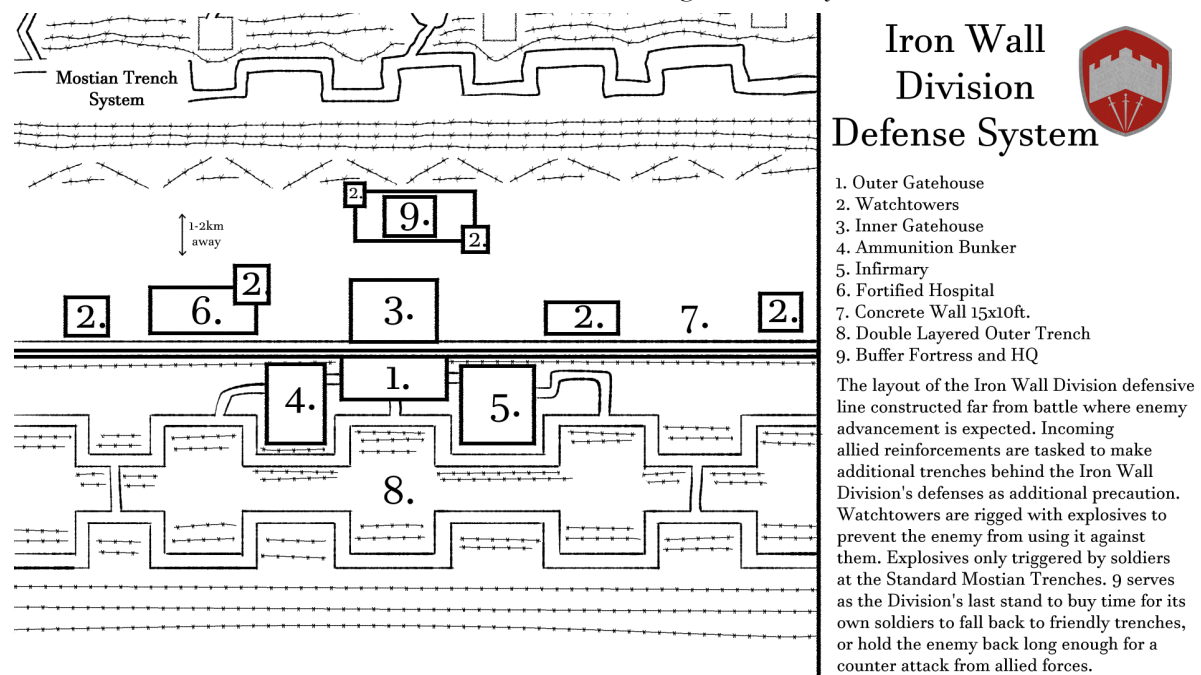
Bayonets are to be fixed at all times.

Soldiers are to throw as many grenades as possible at the enemy within 20 meters range.

Frontline regiment responds to attack first, with veteran regiments providing fire support.

Machine gunners are to keep firing until machine gun ammunition supplies are depleted.

Flamethrowers are to be used within 10 meters range of enemy advance.
